November-December 2024 Call for Papers

After the success of 10SEEDS AT UNIURB – LSYR, the University of Urbino Carlo Bo is glad to purpose the SEEDS AT UNIURB – LSYR – 2nd Edition, a new series of lunch seminars organised by the young researchers of the Department of Economics, Society, Politics (DESP) open to PhD students and post–doc researchers from all the Universities and Research Centres around the world.

The seminar series aims at stimulating an **inter- and multidisciplinary discussion** on micro and macro research on *sustainability, climate change* and other related **crucial topics**, such as *natural disasters, health, finance, crime, A.I., behavioral economics, law, trade, pandemics, conflict, inequalities, labor and gender.* At the same time, this opportunity provides young researchers with a chance to expand their network, get feedback on their research work and disseminate their ideas.

We are pleased to invite you to participate and present either an **extended abstract** (1,000-1,500 words) **or a full paper** at SEEDS AT UNIURB - LSYR, to be held in Urbino between **November and December 2024**.

Eight papers will be selected after a regular *peer-review process*. The seminars will be structured to be as informal as possible to encourage a broad debate. The presentations will be held **in presence of the speaker**, but a virtual room will be organised on the Zoom or Google Meet platform for those who cannot attend the in-person seminars.

Submission of Extended Abstracts or Full Papers by filling the form

Submission deadline: September 30th, 2024

Notification of acceptance: October 15th, 2024

For selected speakers, partial coverage of participation costs is possible.

Reimbursement may include one- or two-nights accommodation in <u>Urbino</u> (3-star hotel or <u>B&B</u>), travel (<u>public transport to/from Urbino</u>) and meals. For foreign speaker, a national tax (fiscal) code is necessary for refunding. Other administrative information will be supplied once the paper is accepted.
